The Department of the Army has contracted to expand the availability of a high quality and high interest after school program for Army-connected youth attending secondary schools not on a military installation. The purpose of the project is to offer an after school program that will provide academic and wellness activities at no charge to the family.

This program will be from 2:30-5:00 Monday through Friday and will be monitored by our teachers and staff. The program will operate each school day, with the exception of early-release days. Students will report to their designated area as soon as our 2:30 dismissal bell rings, arriving no later than 2:45. Students will be offered a healthy snack and a juice drink during their stay. During this time students will be working on homework, and study skills that will be beneficial in their classes. There will also be a time added to go to the gymnasium or outside for a wellness activity. If students wish to attend other clubs, tutoring and other activities, they are to sign in with the after-school program first. All students must be picked up no later than 5:00. Parents are asked to sign their children out each day. Students that are disruptive or not picked up on time will not be allowed to continue in the program. This program is designed to provide a safe and caring student union type environment for active duty army families who need help with afterschool care and structured and safe environment. Mrs. Karin Draxl is our program coordinator.

Only students whose parents are active duty Army/National Guard/Reserves may participate. Please reserve your space now by filling out the form below and returning to the school prior to August 25, 2015.
